Standing Committee Meeting Objective #1

- Begin developing a project plan
- Review Documents:
 - Power point – Chapter 15 of NIST Guide (Communication Systems Document)
 - NIST Planning Guide chapter 15
- Potential Documents.
 - Crosswalk chapter 15 with Table 10-7
 - Develop a version of Table 10-7 customized for a smaller ‘Riverbend’ (<50,000) – large portion of US geography:
 - E.g. what are the community’s back-up capabilities?
 - Develop example for small community specific to communications – walk them through the process
 - Develop FAQs, wiki pages, online tutorials
 - Need feedback loop from communities

Standing Committee Meeting Objective #2

- Develop plan as to how standing committee will develop work products selected:
 - Standing committee level effort or Working groups to address the issue:
 - Each product will be developed at the standing committee level with groups formed to collaborate product points.
 - Panel members from other standing committees will be needed in the work group:
 - Require other standing committees to validate expanded Table 10-7
 - ❑ Social & Economic
 - ❑ Buildings & Facilities
 - ❑ Transportation
 - ❑ Energy
 - ❑ Etc.
 - Want to collaborate with other standing committees and be iterative
