Standing Committee Meeting Objective #1

- Identify barriers to or gaps in implementing energy resilience measures for communities:
 - A strategy to identify barriers and gaps
 - Will most likely need coordination with other committees
 - Products could include information guides and potential mitigation strategies

- Assist the NIST Fellows in development of energy guides (resilience briefs):
 - Standing committee level
 - Work closely with the Fellows
 - Products could include checklists, methodologies, and additional guidance
