Standing Committee Meeting Objective #1

- Begin developing a project plan.
- Plan for Proposal #1:
 - Scalable framework that works for big and smaller systems, coordinated as part of overall community resilience effort.
- Proposal #2:
 - Information dissemination and outreach
 - Leading Practice and Regional Workshops

Standing Committee Meeting Objective #2

- Addresses middle gap of knowledge and processes with key items, e.g. level of service. This would be a next step to implement items in NIST Community Resilience Plan (Vol. 1 and 2).
 - Identify and synthesize existing strategies, policies, practices, tools and techniques that are useful – Many agencies (e.g. NIST) and non-government groups (e.g. ASCE) are developing tools on resilience.
 - Develop guidance approach for integrating resiliency into Master Plan, Asset Management, and/or Capital Replacement Plans; growth and regulatory issues.

Standing Committee Meeting Objective #3

- Tools are translatable as a framework for other utilities.
- Include case studies and example scopes of work.
- Include expert panel workshop approach; and tools, practices and guidelines.
- Matrix of resiliency risk and corresponding available resources as guide for prioritizing.
- Identify financial opportunities to implement.
