Standing Committee Meeting Objective #1

- ***What first steps has the S&E Committee taken with the goal of providing products that support the six-steps in the NIST Community Resilience Planning Guide?***
 - Inventory community resilience resources
 - Review buildings and facilities scenarios to uncover gaps and needs:
 - Examination of 6-step planning process (specifically Steps 1 & 2) – need to know the questions to ask the community to best identify the composition of the collaborative planning team
 - Look at situation first before formulating collaborative planning team
 - Iterative quality
 - Functional level
 - Role of S&E Committee vis a vis other committees

Standing Committee Meeting Objective #2

- ***What are the gaps that the S&E Committee has identified as potential areas to contribute additional products to support communities in becoming more resilient?***
 - Process by which engagement among committees can occur to ensure integration of perspectives (overlay of S&E perspective on what other committees are discussing/accomplishing)
 - Recognition by communities of the importance of business and social service continuity planning and how it ties to the resilience planning process (need commitment/validation by community to expend resources to develop plan)
 - Need for taxonomy of community functions and priorities focused on what needs to be done post-disaster
 - How to make dependencies between social institutions clear

Standing Committee Meeting Objective #3

- ***How is the S&E Committee planning to address the gaps? (i.e., What products are already being developed? What will be developed? What are your next steps?)***
 - Integrate/collaborate with other committees for “cross pollination” (attend committee calls)
 - Identify tools, resources, best practices communities can use for resilience planning (integration with data and metrics committee)
 - Develop taxonomy of community functions and priorities focused on what needs to be done post-disaster
